



Required Winter Attire for the Playground

Boots: If there is snow on the ground, you *must* send your student to school wearing snow boots. If a student does not have snow boots, they will not be allowed to play on any snow (that includes the woodchip area which cannot be plowed) and will be required to stay on the blacktop or sidewalks, assuming they are snow-free.

There are no tennis shoes allowed on snow.

K-2nd Grade: Appropriate attire includes a winter coat, hat or hood, and mittens/gloves. Snow pants are *required* for this age group if they want to play where there is snow. If they do not have snow pants, they will be required to stay on the blacktop or sidewalk, assuming they are snow-free.

3rd-5th Grade: Appropriate attire includes a winter coat, hat or hood, and mittens/gloves. This age group is *not required* to have snow pants to play in the snow. However, students in this age group do play in the snow and do get wet. An extra pair of pants and socks should be kept at school.
